RE: Minimum Temperature Requirements for Self-Adhesive (SA) Membranes

Application of self-adhesive (SA) membranes, are subject to minimum ambient and substrate temperatures. As a general guideline, Polyglass recommends that ambient and substrate temperatures be a minimum of 40F and rising when installing SA membrane products.

In colder climatic conditions, SA membranes should be stored and handled with greater care and in an environment to prevent exposure to freezing temperatures. Often, proper priming and substrate preparation can enhance adhesion in colder climate conditions.
