Re: **SAFETY ADVISORY - Steep-Slope Roof Loading for Polyglass Polystick® Underlayments packaged in plastic wraps**

In support of proper handling and safe installation practices, Polyglass USA issues the following advisory regarding the loading of Polystick underlayment products onto steep slope roofing projects.

Polystick self-adhered underlayments, packaged in plastic wraps, must be loaded onto steep slope roofs only after batten strips have been installed on approved substrates, such as plywood, OSB, or anchor sheets. This precaution is required to ensure the safe and secure loading of rolls prior to installation.

Due to the slippery nature of plastic-wrapped packaging, underlayment rolls may slide if batten strips are not in place. Care should always be taken during the loading process to prevent movement or displacement of the material. The batten strips may be removed once the underlayment installation begins.

Polyglass assumes no liability for damage or injury resulting from underlayment rolls loaded on steep slope roofs without the use of batten strips.
