PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Mapeplan P CA Cleaner is designed for rinsing and maintaining adhesive application equipment, including applicators, hoses, spray tips, and nozzles, for both short- and long-term storage. It may also be used to remove excess or unintended Mapeplan P CA adhesive from membrane surfaces.

TYPICAL APPLICATIONS

- Flushing and cleaning adhesive applicators, hoses, spray tips, and nozzles prior to short- or long-term storage
- Removing Mapeplan P CA adhesive overspray or residue from membrane surfaces and seam areas
- Routine maintenance of adhesive application equipment in the field

USE INSTRUCTIONS

Preparation

- Use only after carefully reviewing all warnings, directions, and first aid instructions provided.
- Perform cleaning operations in a well-ventilated area using appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).

Equipment Preparation

- Close the adhesive canister valve and engage the spray gun trigger to relieve pressure from the gun and hose assembly into an appropriate collection container.
- Disconnect the hose from the adhesive canister outlet.
- Connect the hose to the Mapeplan P CA Cleaner

Cleaning Procedure

- Open the Mapeplan P CA Cleaner canister valve and direct the spray into an appropriate collection container. Engage the spray gun trigger to allow cleaner to flow through the gun and hose assembly.
- Flush a sufficient amount of Mapeplan P CA Cleaner through the equipment to remove residual adhesive.
- Small components such as the nozzle or gun tip may be wiped with a clean rag saturated with cleaner or briefly soaked if necessary.
- Close the cleaner canister valve and engage the spray trigger to relieve any remaining pressure.
- Disconnect the hose from the cleaner canister.
